## Welcome to the first edition of E-News

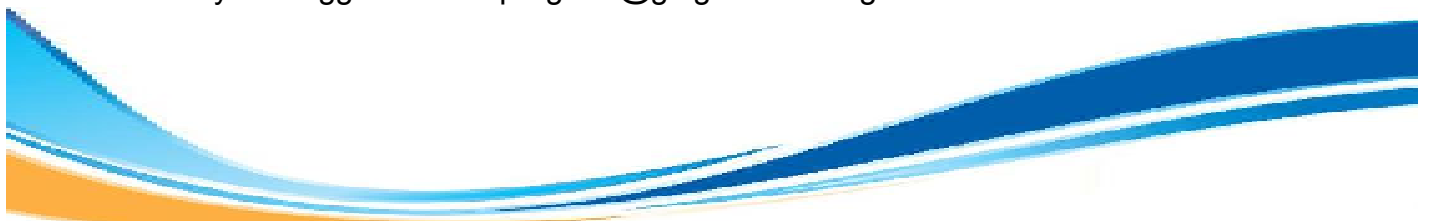

## SenSational 2012

Have you heard about senSational 2012, the State Camp planned for next year?

It runs from **Saturday 7 to Tuesday 10 July** (the middle weekend of the July school holidays) at **Douglas Scrub, Blewitt Springs**. There is also a one night camp (under canvas) from Sunday 8 to Monday 9 July for younger Guides. All Guides and Leaders can attend senSational 2012. If you are 5-9 years, why not think about attending the overnight camp and if you are older consider the 3-night camp. However, all experienced campers who have camped under canvas as Guide for 3 nights (with 2 consecutive) and with a Guide Leader recommendation can attend the 3-night camp. Yes, there will be a 14-17yr program!

**Costs:** The 3-night camp will cost \$450 and the overnight camp \$130. As senSational 2012 is a State event, it incurs State levies and fees, all of which add to the cost of the camp.

**Planned activities** include Zumba, fencing, archery, a climbing wall, bike bungle, geocaching, a Patrol Masterchef competition, Girl Guides have Talent, patrol challenges, hiking, campfire, and of course opening and closing centenary birthday celebrations.

You won't go home empty handed, a beanie and polar vest are included for Guides attending the 3-night camp and there is a beanie for the overnight campers, as well as badges for activities.
