The Queen's Guide Award has a comprehensive syllabus that allows for a broad range of activities ranging from Leadership to Outdoor Skills, Community Involvement and Personal Development.

Earn up to 30 units in Stage 1 and 20 units in Stage 2.

To earn the maximum number of units you need to complete a minimum of 300 hours of community learning. In these hours you will cover these topics:

- 100 hours on the Focus of your choice**
- 50 hours on an interest of your choice**
- 30 hours of Service**
- 50 hours of an Outdoor Qualification**
- 20 hours of Leadership Training**
- 20 hours of Guiding Traditions**
- 20 hours of Promise and Law**
- 20 hours of Patrol System or**
- 20 hours of World Guiding**
